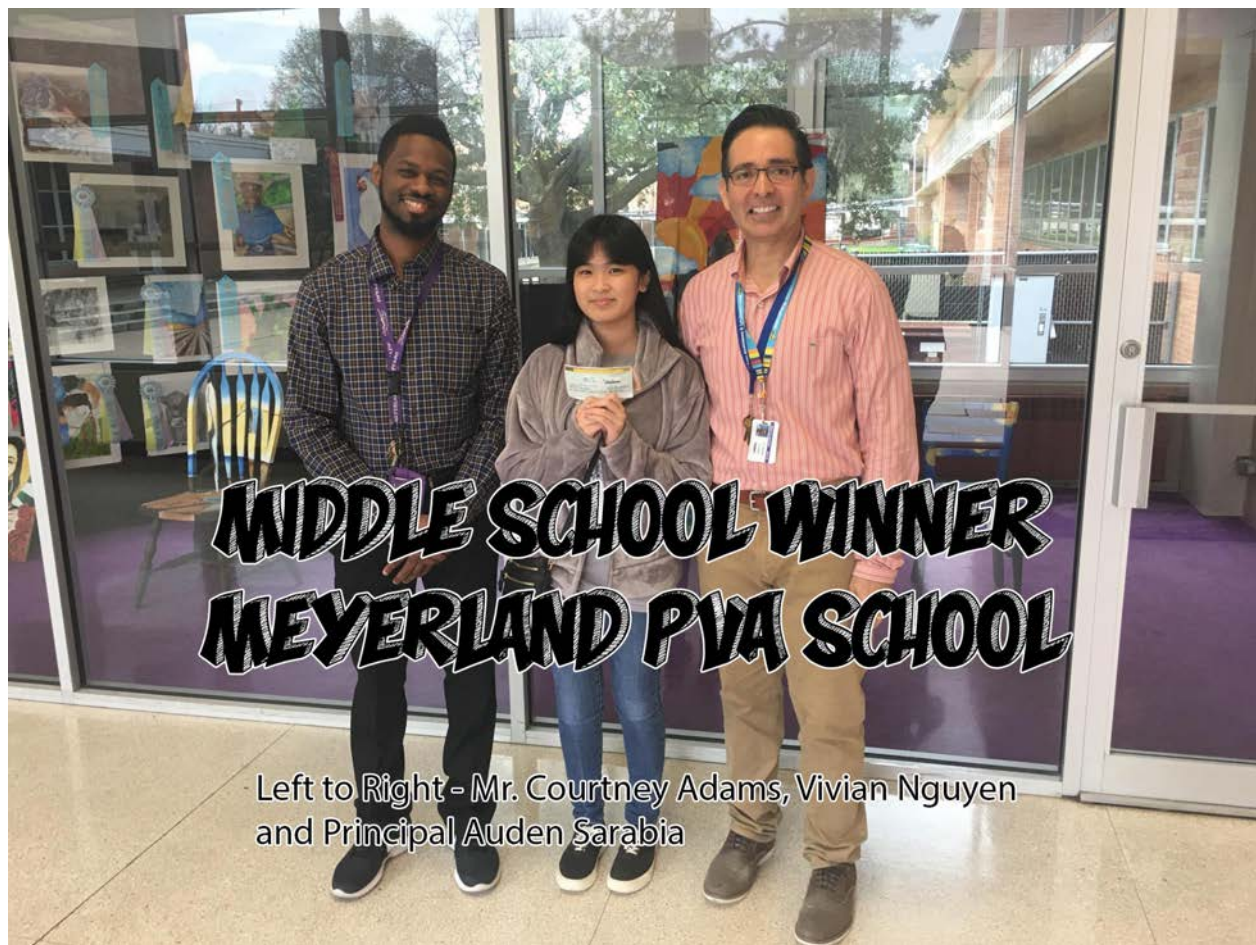

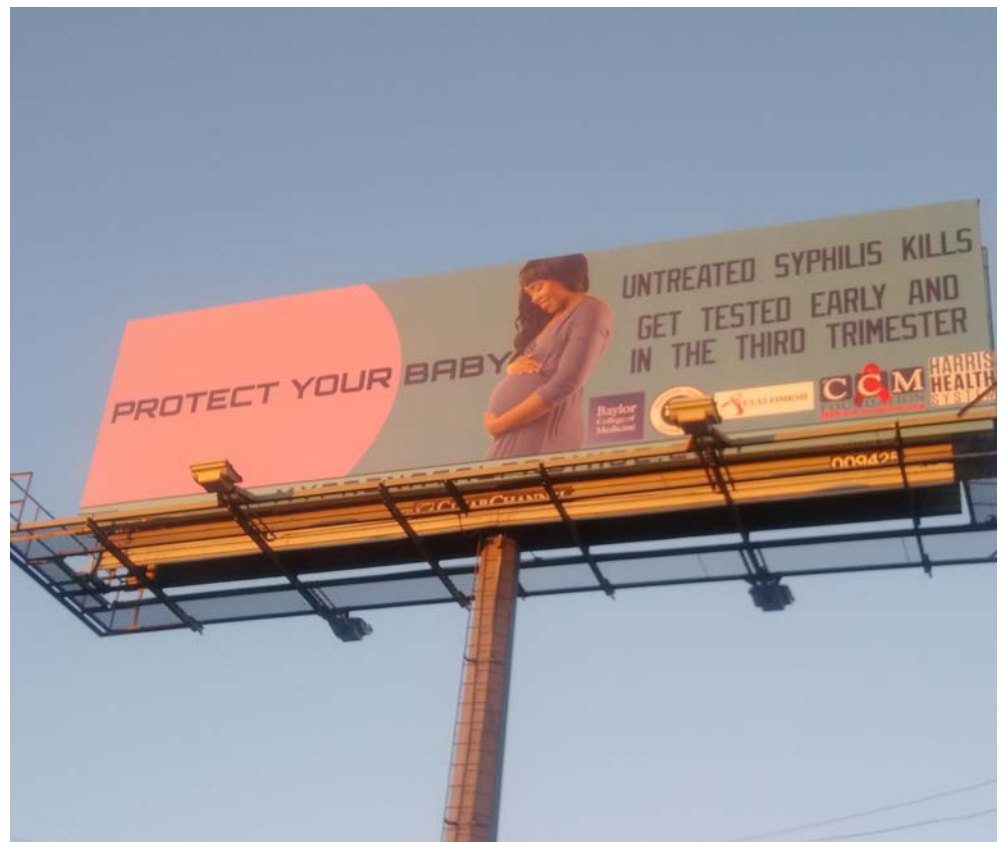
Art On The Streets 2021 Calendar

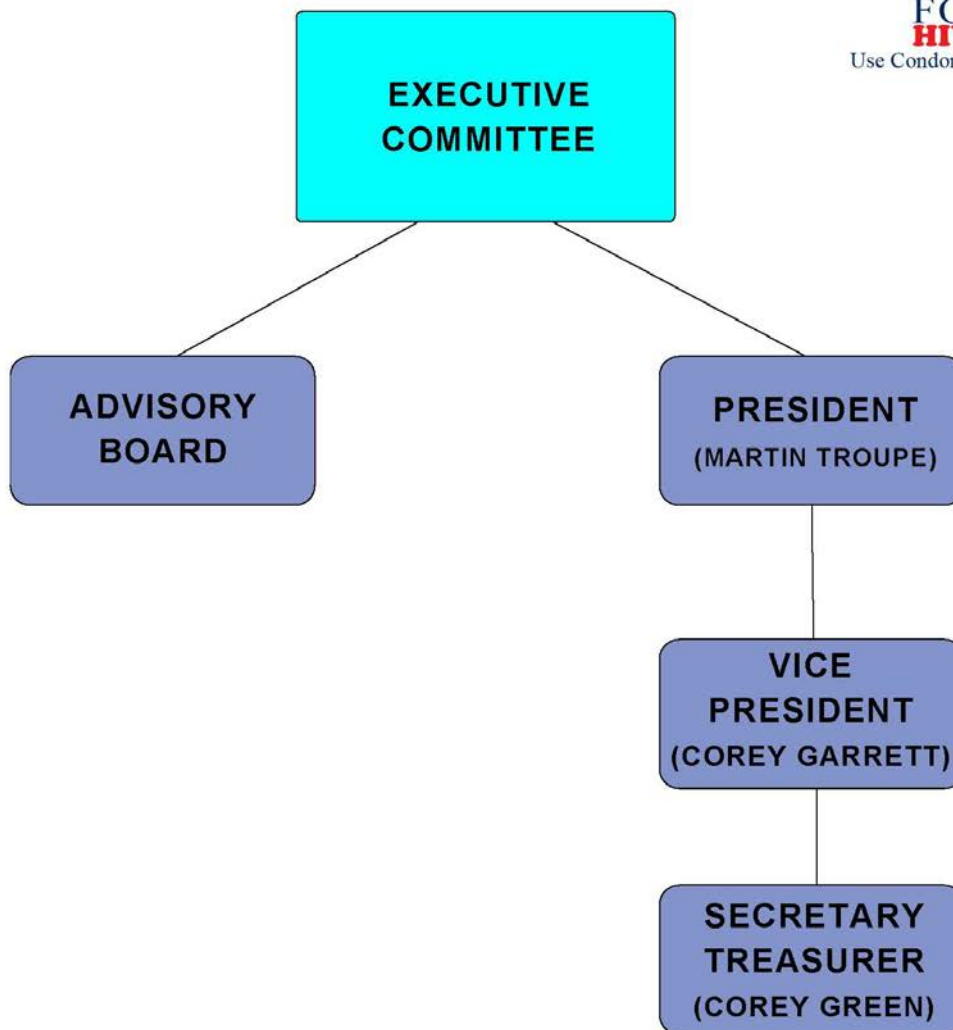
